The German National Library of Science and Technology (TIB) manages the LUH's Open Access Publishing Fund. The TIB collects and uses personal data in order to ensure the fund's services.

The Publishing Fund pays publishing fees for articles in open access journals as well as for open access monographs, provided that the publication meets the funding criteria and sufficient funding is available (<https://www.tib.eu/de/publizieren-archivieren/open-access/open-access-finanzieren/publikationsfonds-leibniz-universitaet#c533>). Authors can request financial support via an online form.

Types of Data

The TIB collects, stores, and uses the following categories of data when you apply for open access funding.

Application data

- E-mail address
- Faculty, institute or unit
- Author name
- Authorship (e.g. corresponding author)
- Co-authors (if applicable)
- Publication name
- Publisher, journal
- Date of acceptance of the article, date of submission (if applicable)
- Amount requested (original currency, net)

Publication and cost data

- Persistent identifier
- Publisher
- Publication type
- Open Access license
- Invoiced amounts
- Amount granted
- Publisher Open access agreement, membership program
- Fiscal year
- DFG project id, if applicable
- DFG subject area

The legal basis is § 2 and 14 of the Act on the German National Library of Science and Technology Foundation¹, and Art. 6 para. 1 a) EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)².

Sharing the data with third parties

The TIB may share the publication and cost data with the Forschungszentrum (FZ) Jülich that runs the monitoring of the DFG funding program "Open Access Publication Costs". For more information, please visit the FZ Jülich website (<https://www.fz-juelich.de/de/zb/open-science/open-access/monitoring-des-dfg-foerderprogramms-open-access-publikationskosten>).

The TIB may pass on the publication and cost data to the Leibniz Universität for the annual accounting of the above-mentioned DFG funding programme.

The TIB will not share the application data with any third party. The data is stored on our servers and is inaccessible to third parties. The TIB will only retain your data for as long as we need it to fulfil any legal, accounting, or reporting requirements.

Your Rights³

You have the right to obtain information about the data stored in this library at any time, as well as on rectification or erasure or on restriction of processing or – as far as the processing is based on your consent – a right of revocation, if necessary a right of objection as well as the right of data portability. Complaints may be lodged with the above-mentioned supervisory authority. The revocation does not affect the lawfulness of the processing of the data carried out up to the time of the revocation.
